## **REQUEST FOR EXPRESSIONS OF INTEREST**

### **Subject: Liaison Jet Aircraft**

The Procurement Division of the United Nations occasionally contracts with Operators for the provision of the subject aircraft type, in support of peace-keeping operations around the world. A typical usage might be a requirement of under two weeks, in support of a liaison/negotiation team of between five and twenty personnel inclusive of support staff, to shuttle between a number of major cities/capitals in a region. Occasionally this is a longer-term requirement.

The intent of this E.O.I notice is to encourage experienced, reputable Operators of the subject aircraft to apply for registration as a UN vendor so that they can be considered for invitation to bid in such solicitations. For aircraft operators, the registration process is in two parts: registration application and technical/operational application. Both need to be completed.
