

## Gender distribution of staff in the Professional and higher categories

# Percentage comparison of women in the professional and higher categories with appointments of one year or more in the United Nations system and IFAD December 2010

#### As of 31 December 2010, women in the UN system constituted:

- **40.3%** (12,005 out of 29,763) of all staff in the professional and higher categories with appointments of one year or more(UG-P2)
- **29.3%** (784 out of 2,674) of all staff at the **D-1 level and above**(UG-D1)
- 41.4% (11,221 out of 27,089) of all staff at the **P level** (P5-P2)

Gender balance has only been achieved at the P-2 level(57.3%).

#### As of 31 December 2010, women in IFAD constituted:

- **42.9%** (121 out of 282) of all staff in the professional and higher categories with appointments of one year or more(UG-P2)
- 25.9% (7 out of 27) of all staff at the **D-1 level and above**(UG-D1)
- **44.7%** (114 out of 255) of all staff at the **P level**(P5-P2)

Gender balance has only been achieved or exceeded at P3level(72.4%), P2 level(52.3%).

# Trends in the representation of women in the Professional and higher categories – 2001 to 2010

<u>Largest increase:</u> **UG** (15.2 percentage points from 15.6% in Dec 2001 to 30.9% in Dec 2010) <u>Smallest increase:</u> **P-2** (4.0 percentage points from 53.3% in Dec 2001 to 57.3% in Dec 2010) <u>Largest increase</u>: **UG(40.0** percentage points from **0.0%** in Dec. 2001 to **40.0%** in Dec. 2010) <u>Largest decrease</u>: **D2(-12.5** percentage points from 25.0% in Dec 2001 to **12.5%** in Dec 2010)
