

## As of 31 December 2009, women in the UN system constituted:

- **39.9%** (11,514 out of 28,849) of all staff in the professional and higher categories with appointments of one year or more;
- **28.4%** (762 out of 2,685) of all staff at the **D-1 level and above**;
- **41.1%** (10,752 out of 26,164) of all staff at the **P level**;

Gender balance has only been achieved at the P-1 (54.8%) and P-2 (57.4%) levels.

Largest increase: UG (3.5% from 24.3% in Dec 2007 to 27.8% in Dec 2009)

Smallest increase: **P-3** (**0.6%** from 43.5% in Dec 2007 to 44.1% in Dec 2009)

As of 31 December 2009, women in ICSC constituted:

- 33.3% (6 out of 18) of all staff in the professional and higher categories with appointments of one year or more;
- 0.0% (0 out of 6) of all staff at the **D-1 level and above**;
- **50.0%** (6 out of 12) of all staff at the **P level**;

**Gender balance** has only been achieved at the **P-2** (100.0%; 1 out of 1) and **P-5** (100.0%; 3 out of 3) levels.

Largest increase: P-2 (66.7% from 33.3% in Dec. 2007 to 100.0% in Dec. 2009); and

**P-5** (**100.0%** from 0.0% in Dec. 2007 to 100.0% in Dec. 2009)

Largest decrease: **P-4** (-38.1% from 71.4% in Dec 2007 to 33.3% in Dec 2009)
